## How to Score a Range Qualification Target Virginia Private Security Course of Fire for Handguns (09E)

1. The Student will need **25 rounds** of Factory loaded or practice or duty Ammunition for qualification on this course.
2. The course shall be fired double action, or double single action except For single action semi-automatic handguns.
3. All qualification shall be conducted using **B-27** silhouette target
4. With prior approval of the department, a reasonable modification of the Firearms course may be approved to accommodate qualification for indoor ranges.
5. A **certified firearms instructor** must be present on the range directly controlling the firing line during all phases of firearms training. There shall be a **minimum of one certified firearms instructor** per **four shooters** on the line shooting.
6. All individuals shall qualify with directional draw holsters.  
The range qualification of individuals shall be scored as follows:

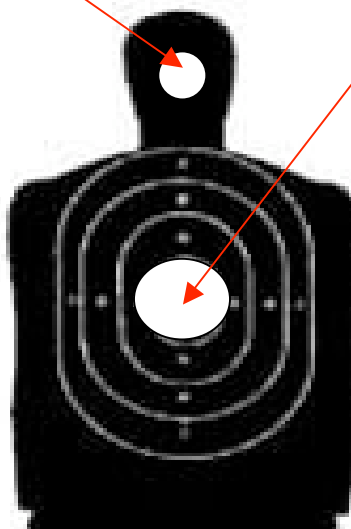
This course of fire is 25 rounds the student will shoot at a B-27 target with the following requirements:

1. 4" diameter circle drawn in the head.
2. 8" diameter circle drawn in the chest/body area.
3. Center points of the circles are 13" apart.

All rounds fired must hit within these circles for the shot to be scored a point. Hits outside the two circles but still on the silhouette are still considered a miss.

Minimum qualification score: 92% (23 hits and 2 misses to qualify)
