Training designed to give the basic knowledge and practice (dry ditching or wet ditching) to Military and Contract crew members so that they may react adequately when a water or land ditching occurs, in accordance with the military procedures and national and international civil aviation regulations. Equipment is supplied during the training. The student will receive a certificate. This program is designed to assist flight crew and cabin crew members to survive in any situations through knowledge and hands-on experience with survival equipment.
